Dear Hon. Mayor D'Amico and Members of the West Hollywood City Council:

The purpose of this letter is to express the Apartment Association of Greater Los Angeles' (AAGLA) support of the Council's exploration and consideration of a smoke-free multifamily dwelling program. We have collaborated with the University of California at Los Angeles (UCLA) and the Los Angeles Housing + Community Investment Department (LAHCID) to establish guidelines for adopting smoke-free multifamily housing policies. We recognize the multitude of health benefits and cost savings that may result following the implementation of a smoke-free policy.

As the Council deliberates the advancement of a smoke-free multifamily dwelling program, AAGLA requests that the following recommendations be considered: that the program be phased-in to allow sufficient time for rental housing providers to made necessary modifications and that the program remain voluntary for existing renters.
